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

This year the Myerson employment survey had a high response rate with 90% of employees completing the survey. This was up 4% from last year.




# Q1. Which best describes your role in the firm?








# Q2. Which age category are you in?




Q3. What is your sex?






# Q4. Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?




# Q5. Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?




# Q6. Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?






## Q7. What is your ethnic group?






# Q8. What is your religion or belief?




## Q9. What is your sexual orientation?






# Q10. What type of school did you mainly attend between the ages 11 and 16?




Q11. Did either of your parents attend university by the time you were 18?


